

Medical Insurance

Students studying in Canada are required to have medical insurance. **Students attending PCS are required to take out medical insurance through the school.**

Pacific Christian School has partnered with **GUARD.ME** and their **STUDENT GUARD** Health Insurance program. The school considers this insurance to be superior to other programs available because of the unique features it has for international students and their families. All other clinics, including the hospitals, will require you pay before you receive treatment. They will give you an invoice after treatment and you should make a claim directly to Guard.Me using their website (you will need access to a scanner).

Students will be billed \$700.00 per year (or a portion thereof for shorter term students) for medical insurance on their tuition invoice.
