Pacific Christian School is seeking a Learning Support Coordinator for Grades 8 – 12.

The Learning Support Coordinator will:

- possess current British Columbia teacher certification and additional relevant education and/or experience in the area of supporting students with diverse learning needs.
- work collaboratively with the Inclusion Support Services Coordinator.
- consult with students, families, and staff to develop and implement Individualized Educational Plans for students with designated learning disabilities and Student Support Plans for students needing additional support.
- support educators to implement universal and individualized strategies to enhance learning for students with diverse learning needs.
- work with students 1-on-1 in pull-out or push-in settings to teach organization, learning, and self-regulation strategies.
- collaborate in the hiring, training, and scheduling of Educational Assistants.
- demonstrate organizational and planning skills, as well as strong written and verbal communication skills with both adults and young people.
- have a vibrant Christian faith and a desire to foster Christian faith formation in young people.
- desire to become an active, contributing, collaborative member of a professional learning community.
